MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1968.

2. Part III of the first Schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the renumbering of item 42 as item 42(1); and
- (b) by the addition thereto of the following paragraph as paragraph (2) of item 42 —

“(2) Films, chemicals, ink, silk fabric, nylon fabric, polyvinyl chloride in sheets, paper and paper board, for silk screen process printing, admitted as such by the Comptroller when imported by or on behalf of a silk screen process printing establishment.”
