THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE

(Chapter 191)

UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 9 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Construction) Order 1968.
2. The Board shall cause to be re-aligned and re-constructed the sea defence described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

The sea defence extending from Plantation Wallers Delight to a point approximately 400 feet east of the eastern boundary of Plantation Nouvelle Flanders, on the West Coast of Demerara, in the Sea Defence District No. 4.
