THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957,

(No. 34 of 1957)

UNDER SECTION 21 (2) OF THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE BY THE MINISTER FOR THE TIME BEING CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE GUYANA ELECTRICITY CORPORATION:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Maximum Prices) Order, 1968, and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. The limits of price specified in the second schedule to the Electricity Ordinance, 1957, as amended from time to time, are hereby altered by the substitution of the provisions of the schedule to this Order for the provisions of the said second schedule.

SCHEDULE

The limit of price for electricity supplied by the Corporation shall be fifteen cents per kilowatt-hour and, in addition thereto, in respect of each supply of electricity provided by the Corporation, such service or standing charge and such fuel variation charge as may be provided for in the tariffs of the Corporation from time to time applicable to such supply and such amount, if any, as may be required to make the price calculated as aforesaid equal to any applicable minimum charge provided for in such tariffs.
