MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE
(Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE BY THE MINISTER FOR THE TIME BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR FINANCE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1968.

2. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition thereto of the following paragraph to item 27 —

- “18. (a) Fittings for goods made of leather cloth;
(b) handles and handle fillers;
(c) beading, binding and piping, made of plastic;
(d) wire piping,

when imported for use by or on behalf of a manufacturer of travel goods provided the Comptroller is satisfied that they will be used solely for that purpose.
