THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and all amendments thereto.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended by the deletion therefrom of number 16 (stockfeeds), in the said schedule.

3. The first schedule to the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1968** is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the addition to Part A thereof, of the number and article with the particulars set out against them, as specified in Part A of the schedule to this Order; and
- (b) by the addition to Part B thereof, of the number and article with the particulars set out against them, as specified in Part B of the schedule to this Order.
