THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 71).

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Fitzgerald (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1968.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policy of insurance in the sum of two thousand dollars effected on the life of Emmet Edward Fitzgerald with the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister responsible for finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policy of insurance to said Emmet Edward Fitzgerald and to pay over to him the proceeds of such policy of insurance and any increase thereon.
