ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 71)

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cox (Transfer of Insurance Policies) Order, 1969.

2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the two policies of insurance numbered 16307E and 19714, respectively, effected on the life of PHILIP CUTHBERT COX with the Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister responsible for Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said PHILIP CUTHBERT COX and his wife LILIAN AMY MURIEL COX and to pay over to them the proceeds of such policies of insurance and any increases thereon.
