THE BILL OF ENTRY (IN AID OF DEFENCE) LEVY ACT, 1969 :

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE BILL OF ENTRY (IN AID OF DEFENCE) LEVY ACT, 1969, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE MINISTER CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR FINANCE :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Bill of Entry (Defence Levy) (Exemption) Order, 1969.
2. Bills of entry relating to —
 - (a) goods, not otherwise exempted from the defence levy imposed by the provisions of the Bill of Entry (In Aid of Defence) Levy Act, 1969, and upon which the imposition of the Defence Levy would be inconsistent with the provisions of the Agreement mentioned in Section 2 of the Customs (Amendment) Act, 1968; and
 - (b) goods classified in Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance under the group or item number 892 and entered free of Import duty, are hereby exempt from the defence levy.
