SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ORDINANCE, 1965
(No. 7 of 1965)

UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE
OF ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ORDI-
NANCE, 1965, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER
POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE
THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Ministers, Members of the National Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) Order, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Ministers, Members of the House of Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) Order 1965, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and all amendments thereto.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1969.

2. The schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects :—

- (a) by the substitution of the number "250" for the number "120" in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 1, and in paragraph 3;
- (b) by the substitution of the number "175" for the number "120" in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 1;
- (c) by the substitution of the number "130" for the number "65" in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 2;
- (d) by the substitution of the number "120" for the number "80" in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 2;
- (e) by the deletion of sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph 4 and the substitution therefor of the following sub-paragraph —

- “(a) travelling allowance at the rate of 30 cents per mile for every mile travelled in a car owned by him;” and
- (f) by re-lettering sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 4 as sub-paragraph (b).
