THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS —

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Order, 1969.

2. Owing to the presence in the area described in the schedule to this Order of cases of Foot and Mouth Disease and the necessity for preventing the spread of such disease, the area aforesaid is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the Animals Diseases Ordinance, an area infected with Foot and Mouth Disease.

SCHEDULE

The area bounded as follows —

- On the North by the parallel of latitude 5°N,
- On the South by the boundary between Guyana and Brazil,
- On the East by the boundary between Guyana and Surinam,
- On the West by the Ireng and Takatu Rivers.
