THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959
(No. 18 of 1959)

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Lighttown/Macaw) Order, 1970.
2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

The area of land known as Lighttown and Macaw, the said area of land being situated on the right bank Berbice River in the county of Berbice and bounded as follows:—
