THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 33 of 1958).

UNDER THE PROVISIO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shops Hours (Special Provision) Order, 1970.

2. Every shop, other than a restaurant, parlour or cookshop, barber or hairdresser's establishment within the urban area (as defined in section 2 of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958), the occupier of which notifies the Commissioner of Police not later than the 14th February, 1970, that the shop will be open during the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. during the period 16th February, 1970 to 28th February, 1970, both dates inclusive, may be open during the said hours on the dates so notified.
