ORDER
MADE UNDER
THE TRADE ORDINANCE
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE BY THE PRESIDENT:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Regulation of the Sale and Export of Copper) Order, 1970.

2. In this Order, "copper" means copper wire, and scrap metal made of copper.

3. No copper shall be exported to any country except under the authority of a licence granted by the Competent Authority.

4. No person, other than the Guyana Telecommunication Corporation, shall sell copper in Guyana unless he has obtained from the Minister for the time being assigned responsibility for public order (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") a permit for the purpose in the form set out as Form No. 1 in the schedule. Application for the permit shall be made in the form set out as Form No. 2 in the schedule.

5. No person shall purchase copper in Guyana unless the seller produces to him a permit issued to the seller for the purpose by the Minister in the form set out as Form No. 1 in the schedule. Application for the permit shall be made in the form set out as Form No. 2 in the schedule.

6. Every person who deals in copper shall —

(a) keep a book in which he shall record, on each occasion, the particulars required according to Form No. 3 in the schedule;

(b) record in the said book, on each occasion, the particulars required according to Form No. 4 in the schedule;

and every entry in any such book shall be deemed, unless the contrary is shown, to have been made by or with the authority of the dealer in copper to whom the book belongs.

7. For the purpose of securing compliance with this Order —

(a) the Competent Authority, or any person authorised by him or the Minister in writing, or any member of the Police Force, may enter and inspect any premises in which he has reasonable cause to believe that there may be any copper intended for export or sale contrary to the provisions of this Order;

- (b) any person carrying on any trade or business in copper shall produce to the Competent Authority or the Minister, or any person authorised by him or the Minister in writing in that behalf, such books, accounts or other documents relating to his trade or business as the Competent Authority or the Minister may require, and shall furnish the Competent Authority or the Minister with such returns or information as the Competent Authority or the Minister may, from time to time, require.
