

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT, 1969,
(No. 24 of 1969).

UNDER SECTION 33 OF THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT, 1969, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MINISTER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Grove/Haslington Local Government District (Constitution) Order, 1970.
2. That portion of Guyana in the county of Demerara, the boundaries of which are set out in the schedule, is hereby established as a local government district to be known by the name of "The Grove/Haslington Local Government District", hereinafter referred to as "the district".
3. The district council for the district shall have the name of "The Grove/Haslington District Council", hereinafter referred to as "the District Council", and shall consist of fifteen councillors.
4. The District Council may, in each year, appropriate out of its funds a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars to be placed at the disposal of the Chairman payable in equal instalments at the end of each quarter of the year.
5. The District Council shall appoint and at all times maintain a Finance Committee as a Standing Committee.
6. There shall be a Superintendent of Works for the District Council.
7. The District Council shall have power to do all or any of the things specified in section 301 of the Act except the things specified in paragraphs (22) and (26) thereof.

SCHEDULE

Clause 2

BOUNDARIES OF THE GROVE/HASLINGTON LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT —

Being all that area situate in the County of Demerara and bounded as follows —

- On the North — by the Atlantic Ocean.
- On the South — by the East Demerara Water Supply Canal; and the Shanks Canal.
- On the East — by the common boundary between Unity and Grove or Chapman Grove; and the Shanks Canal.
- On the West — by the common boundary between Haslington and Enmore, and its prolongation southwards along the extra depths.
