**UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, I HEREBY
MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—**

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order 1969* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 10) Order, 1971.

2.
