ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 132)

UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,  
THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Rates of Postage (Surface Mail) and Fees for Services Order, 1971.

2. (1) On and after 1st January, 1972, the rates of postage to be paid in respect to the communications and postal packets specified in the first column of the first schedule when addressed to places within Guyana, shall be those set out in the second column of that schedule.

(2) On and after 1st December, 1971, the rates of postage to be paid in respect of the communications and postal packets specified in the first column of the first schedule when addressed to places within the Commonwealth excluding Guyana shall be those set out in the third column of that schedule and the rates of postage to be paid when such communications and postal packets are addressed to places outside the Commonwealth, shall be those set out in the fourth column of that schedule.

3. (1) On and after 1st January, 1972, the fees to be paid for the services specified in the first column of the second schedule when those services are required for places within Guyana, shall be the fees set out in the second column of that schedule.

(2) On and after 1st December, 1971, the fees to be paid for the services specified in the first column when those services are required for places within the Commonwealth excluding Guyana, shall be those set out in the third column of that schedule and the fees to be paid when such services are required in relation to places outside the Commonwealth, shall be those set out in the fourth column of that schedule.

4. The Rates of Postage Order, 1967,\* is hereby revoked.
