THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE
(Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1972.

2. During the continuance in force of this Order the rates of duty set out in the second and third columns of the Schedule to this Order as a Preferential rate and a General rate, respectively, against the item number mentioned in the first column of that Schedule shall be payable in lieu of the like rate of duty as set out against that item number in Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Ordinance.

Explanatory Note

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport). This Order substitutes a rate of \$3.00 per lb. for the rate of \$6.70 per lb. which is prescribed by the Customs Ordinance as the Preferential and General rates for unmanufactured leaf tobacco containing less than 25% of moisture and unmanufactured tobacco offals.
