THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958
(No. 34 of 1958);

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, I HEREBY
MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order 1969 may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 14) Order 1972.

2. Part A of the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of that Part against the article of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and numbered 23 (Onions), of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns of Part A of the Schedule to this Order against the same article of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said number.

3. Part B of the First schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of that Part against the article of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and numbered 23 (Onions) of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns of Part B of the Schedule to this Order against the same article of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said number.
