THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958  
(No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1959, I HEREBY  
MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order 1969\* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 21) Order, 1972.

2. Part A of the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution, for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, against the articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and numbered 21 (Potatoes) and 23 (Onions), of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of Part A of the schedule to this Order against the same articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said respective numbers.

3. Part B of the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, against the articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and numbered 21 (Potatoes) and 23 (Onions), of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of Part B of the schedule to this Order against the same articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said respective numbers.
