
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Whim/Bloomfield) Orders, 1973.

Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958, every shop (other than restaurants, parlours, cookshops, barbers' and hairdressers' establishments) in the area described in the first schedule is hereby permitted to open during the hours prescribed in the second schedule.
