THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958

(No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1969,* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 30) Order 1973.

2.
