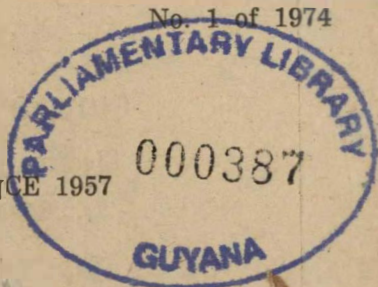

THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE 1957

(No. 34 of 1957)



IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME UNDER SECTION 21(2) OF THE ELECTRICITY ORDINANCE, 1957, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity (Maximum Prices) Order 1973 and shall come into force forthwith.
2. The limit of price specified in the Second Schedule to the Electricity Ordinance 1957 is hereby altered by the substitution of the provisions in the Schedule to this Order for the provisions of the Second Schedule to the Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

1. The limit of price for electricity supplied by the Corporation shall be fifteen cents per kilowatt-hour.
2. Where a persons uses electricity that costs the minimum charge or more than the minimum charge specified in the tariffs of the Corporation, the Corporation shall, in addition to the limit of price mentioned in paragraph 1. charge for each supply of electricity—
  - (a) the service or standing charge; and
  - (b) the fuel variation charge,specified in the tariffs.
3. Where a person uses electricity that costs less than the minimum charge specified in the tariffs of the Corporation, the Corporation shall charge the minimum charge specified in the tariffs.
