THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER —

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Fish Processing Plant) Order, 1974.

2. The proposed construction of a Fish Processing Plant on the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants and workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A portion of land being part of Plantation Houston situate on the East Bank of the Demerara River, in the county of Demerara and bounded as follows:—

**ON THE NORTH:**

By the East Bank Demerara Public Road on the common boundary between Plantations Ruimveldt and Houston and the western prolongation of the centre line of the said public road to the channel of the Demerara River.

**ON THE EAST:**

By the East Bank Demerara Public Road.

**ON THE SOUTH:**

By the common boundary between Plantations Houston and Rome, and its western prolongation to the channel of the Demerara River.

**ON THE WEST:**

By the channel of the Demerara River.
