MADE UNDER
THE TRADE ACT
(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order* ^{Citation.} may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 51) Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended —

(a) by the substitution in Part B of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns respectively thereof, in relation to the article numbered 20 (Batteries), of the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively of Part A of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same article and to the said number; and

(b) by the substitution in the respective columns of Part C of the Fourth Schedule thereto in relation to the article numbered 20 (Batteries), of the particulars specified in the respective columns of Part B of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same article and the said number.
