IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 62) Order 1974. Citation.
