IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order\* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 82) Order 1974. Citation.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended —

(a) by the addition to the respective columns of Part A of the Fourth Schedule thereto, of the number, article and the particulars relating to that number and article, specified in the respective columns of Part A of the Schedule hereto; and
