## ORDER

Made Under

THE TRADE ACT

(CHAPTER: 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Regulations of the Sale of Agricultural Machinery) Order 1975.

2. In this Order "motor tractor" means a motor vehicle which is registrable under the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act as a motor tractor.

3. No person shall sell any of the goods to which this Order applies unless the purchaser thereof delivers to him a permit issued to the purchaser for the purpose by the Chief Agricultural Officer in the form set out as Form No. 1 in the schedule. Application for the permit shall be made in the form set out as Form No. 2 in the schedule.

4. No person shall purchase any of the goods to which this Order applies unless at the time of such purchase he is in respect thereof the holder of a permit as mentioned in clause 3.

5. Every person, who in the course of his business sells any of the goods to which this Order applies, shall —

- (a) keep a book in which he shall record, on each occasion, the particulars required according to Form No. 3 in the Schedule;
- (b) record in the said book, on each occasion, the particulars required according to Form No. 4 in the schedule;

and every entry in any such book shall be deemed, unless the contrary is shown, to have been made by or with the authority of that person to whom the book belongs.

6. For the purposes of securing compliance with this Order —

- (a) the Competent Authority, or any person authorised by him in writing, or the Chief Agricultural Officer or police

constable, may enter and inspect any premises in which he has reasonable cause to believe that there may be thereon for sale any of the goods to which this Order applies or which have been purchased, contrary to the provisions of this Order;

- (b) any person carrying on any trade or business involving the sale of any of the goods to which this Order applies shall produce to the Competent Authority or any person authorised by him in writing in that behalf, such books, accounts or other documents relating to his trade or business as the Competent Authority or such person may require, and shall furnish the Competent Authority with such returns or information as the Competent Authority may, from time to time, require.

7. This Order applies to motor tractors, combine harvesters, mechanical threshers, disc barrows, disc ploughs, mouldboard ploughs and rotovators.
