## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

The definitions of the expressions "the Court", "the Registrar" and "the registry", as they appeared in section 2 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinance, Chapter 30 of the 1953 Edition of the Laws of British Guiana, were modified in 1966 by the Guyana Independence (Adaptation Modifications of Laws) (Judicature) Order, 1966. These definitions as so modified represented the law in force when the Revised Edition of the Laws of Guyana came into force on 31st December, 1973, but are not reflected in the definitions of the expressions as they appear in section 2 of the Legal Practitioners Act, Chapter 4:01 of that Edition.
