THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT
(Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER —

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of quarters for employees of the Clay Brick Factory) Order 1976.

2. The proposed construction of quarters to house persons employed by the Government in the operations of the Clay Brick Factory on the land described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. The Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants and workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

The western portion of Lot No. 1 and Lot No. 2 Plantation Mon DeSir, Canal No. 2, in the Canal's Polder Local Authority, situate on the West Bank of the Demerara River, in the county of Demerara, Guyana, the said Lots Nos. 1 and 2 being shown on a plan by J. T. Seymour, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 21st August, 1933 and deposited in the Deeds Registry of Georgetown, on 28th August, 1933, and which western portion is bounded as follows:—

- ON THE NORTH:** By the southern embankment of the No. 2 Canal.
- ON THE EAST:** By the western boundary of the road reserve of that Public Road known as Wales Access Road.
- ON THE SOUTH:** By the dam immediately north of 'C' Line Irrigation Canal.
- ON THE WEST:** By an imaginary line 200 ft. west of and parallel to the centre line of Wales Access Road.
