THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

WHEREAS, by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Government Offices) (Water Street, Georgetown) Order 1976* made on the 3rd day of July, 1976, the proposed construction of buildings to accommodate offices of the Government on the land described in the Schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order, the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants and workmen, was authorised under section 4 of the Act, to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer, together with a plan of the land to be acquired has been laid before the Minister;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the Schedule to this Order, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Government Offices) (Water Street, Georgetown) (No. 2) Order 1976.

SCHEDULE

Lot "A" being a parcel of land comprising of Mud Lot 20 also known as Water Lot 20, and the northern portion of Mud Lot 21 also known as Water Lot 21, and situate in the Cummingsburg Ward, Georgetown.

The boundaries of the said Lot "A" commence at an iron paal marked J. T. S., on the north-eastern corner of Mud Lot (Water Lot) 20, the said iron paal being 34.75 ft. west of the centre line of Water Street, measured along the eastern prolongation of the northern boundary of the said Mud Lot (Water Lot) 20 and 409.14 ft. south of the centre line of Holmes Street, measured along the centre line of Water Street.

From the aforesaid iron paal J.T.S., the boundaries of the said Lot "A" extend as follows:—

S $11^{\circ} 28' W$ (tr.) for a distance of 85.46 feet to an iron paal J.T.S., thence N $75^{\circ} 26' 00'' W$ (tr.) for a distance of 469.0 feet to a wooden paal G.P., thence N $13^{\circ} 28' 41'' E$ (tr.) for a distance of 85.35 feet to a wooden paal G.P., thence S $75^{\circ} 26' 00'' E$ (tr.) for a distance of 466.0 feet back to the point of commencement.

The said Lot "A" contains an area of 0.916 acre and is shown bordered red on a plan by Gobin Persaud, Sworn Land Surveyor dated 24th September, 1976, and recorded on the 18th October, 1976, in the Department of Lands and Surveys, of the Ministry of Agriculture as plan No. 17253.
