ORDER  
MADE UNDER  
THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939,  
(No. 31 of 1939).

UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) (Amendment) (French Indo-China) Order, 1947.

2. Paragraphs 3, 6 and 7 of the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1940,\* (requiring payment of certain moneys to the Custodian and imposing restrictions and requirements in regards to certain property in the Colony) shall not apply to—

- (a) any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit of any person within the description contained in paragraph 3 of this Order on or after the date of this Order;
- (b) any property which on or after the date of this Order comes into the ownership of any such person as aforesaid;
- (c) any money or property to which the abovementioned paragraphs of the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1940, would apply only because any such persons as aforesaid became resident or commenced or recommenced to carry on business in French Indo-China on or after the 15th day of August, 1945.

3. This Order applies—

- (a) to any individual resident in French Indo-China;
- (b) as respects any business carried on in French Indo-China to any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business;
- (c) as respects any business carried on in any territory which is not an area which is for the time being to be treated as enemy territory for the purposes of section 9 of the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance, 1939, in accordance with the provisions of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1943,\*\* to any body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) carrying on that business if and so long as the body is controlled by any individual resident in or body of persons carrying on business in French Indo-China.
