

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE
(Chapter 169).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. Under section 4 (1) of the above Ordinance the land specified in the petition of Francis A. Carryl of La Retraite, West Bank, Demerara, and others dated the 16th day of February, 1943, which said land is described in the Schedule hereto, shall be subject to the provisions of the above Ordinance.

2. Under Section 5 (a) of the above Ordinance, James Lawrence Yhap, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the officer to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot, the land described in the Schedule hereto.

3. Order in Council No. 21 of 1944 published in the *Official Gazette* of the 29th of April, 1944. is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE.

(Description of Land Specified in Petition).

That portion of Plantation La Retraite, situate on the left Bank, Demerara River, in the County of Demerara, containing an area of 750 English acres more or less, and bounded on the North by the common boundary between Plantations La Retraite and Tœvlugt, and on the South by the Northern boundary of Stanleytown Village, on the East by the Demerara River and on the west by the common boundary between Plantations La Retraite and Middlesex, all as shown and defined on a plan by H. O. Durham, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 30th October, 1926, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as plan No. 3306.
