ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1961

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of Article 21 of the Constitution of British Guiana that the Governor acting with the concurrence of the Premier may, from time to time by order published in the Gazette, prescribe the offices that are to constitute the personal staff of the Governor, the salaries and allowances that are to be paid to the members of the personal staff of the Governor, and the other sums that are to be paid in respect of the expenditure attaching to the office of Governor;

AND WHEREAS on the 15th day of July, 1961, the Governor acting in pursuance of the said provisions made an order prescribing the offices that are to constitute the personal staff of the Governor and the salaries and allowances that are to be paid to the members of the personal staff of the Governor, and the other sums that are to be paid in respect of the expenditure attaching to the office of Governor;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (9) of article 115 of the Constitution of British Guiana that where any power is conferred by the said Constitution to make any proclamation, order, rules or regulations or to give any directions, the power shall be construed as including a power exercisable in like manner to amend or revoke any such proclamation, order, rules, regulations or directions:

NOW THEREFORE I, acting with the concurrence of the Premier, do hereby amend the aforesaid Order by the substitution of the number "2,500" for the number "2,000" appearing against the item "Telegrams and Carriage of Mails" in Part II of the schedule to the said order.
