**THE MINING ACT**  
**(No. 20 of 1989)**

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 10 OF THE MINING ACT 1989, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Reservation

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospecting and Mining for minerals and metals) Reservation Order 2008 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on August 22<sup>nd</sup> 2008.

Citation

2. The area hereinafter described in the Schedule below is hereby reserved by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission for prospecting and mining of minerals and metals but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area mining or prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.

**SCHEDULE**


Tract of State Land within the following boundaries commencing from:

Point A located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 0' 25" W and latitude 8° 47' 19" N, thence at true bearing of 198° for a distance of approximately 12 miles 901 yards, to Point B located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 3' 49" W and latitude 8° 36' 59" N, thence at true bearing of 192° for a distance of approximately 1 mile 633 yards, to Point C located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 4' 4" W and latitude 8° 35' 50" N, thence at true bearing of 191° for a distance of approximately 49 miles 759 yards, to Point D located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 12' 23" W and latitude 7° 53' 42" N, thence at true bearing of 191° for a distance of approximately 15 miles 1492 yards, to Point E located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 15' 3" W and latitude 7° 40' 12" N, thence at true bearing of 203° for a distance of approximately 13 miles 1265 yards, to Point F located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 19' 45" W and latitude 7° 29' 14" N thence at a true bearing of 202° for a distance of approximately 3 miles 996 yards to Point G located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 20' 56" W and latitude 7° 26' 22" N thence at true bearing of 207° for a distance of approximately 2 miles 251 yards to Point H located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 21' 48" W and latitude 7° 24' 43" N, thence at true bearing of 207° for a distance of approximately 34 miles 1408 yards to Point J, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 56° 35' 32" W and latitude 6° 57' 44" N, thence at true bearing of 299° for a distance of approximately 99 miles 1246 yards to Point K

located at geographical coordinates of longitude 57° 52' 8" W and latitude 7° 39' 16" N, thence at true bearing of 312° for a distance of approximately 130 miles 1597 yards to Point L located at geographical coordinates of longitude 59° 17' 7" W and latitude 8° 55' 46" N thence at true bearing of 29° for a distance of approximately 106 miles 1576 yards to Point M located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58° 31' 44" W and latitude 10° 17' 6" N thence at true bearing of 121° for a distance of approximately 200 miles 937 yards to point of commencement at Point A.

Thus enclosing an area of approximately 17,328,335 acres, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.
