IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED

OF THE MINING ACT, 1989, I HEREBY
MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (Prospecting and Mining for Minerals and Metals) Reservation order, 2010, and shall be deemed to have come into effect of April 1, 2010.


Reservation.

2. The area hereinafter described in the Schedule below is hereby reserved by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission for prospecting and mining of minerals and metals but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area mining or prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.

SCHEDULEDESCRIPTION

From a reference point at the left bank Mahdia Creek located with geographical coordinates of Latitude 59°09'13.0" Longitude 05°16'32.0" thence at a true bearing of 319° for a distance of .25 miles to point 'A' being the point of commencement located with coordinates of Latitude 59°09'23.8" Longitude 05°16'39.1" thence at a true bearing of 163° for a distance of 1319 feet to point 'B' located with coordinates of Latitude 59°09'16.6" Longitude 05°16'28.2" thence at a true bearing of 261° for a distance of 800 feet to point 'C' located with coordinates of Latitude 59°09'23.8" Longitude 05°16'24.9" thence at a true bearing of 358° for a distance of 469 feet to point 'D' located with coordinates of Latitude 59°09'16.6" Longitude 05°16'28.8" thence at a true bearing of 24° for a distance of 1004 feet to point 'A' being the point of commencement.
