THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS)
ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION
3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF
HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Hold-^{Citation}ers' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1988.

2. Clauses 5(1) and 11(ii) of the Principal Order as amended ^{Amendment} by the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) ^{of the} Principal ^{Order.} Order 1986 is hereby amended by the insertion of the following Table as Table III to the latter order.

"TABLE III"

Chauffeur allowance for 1987 and subsequent years

PART A

Where a chauffeur in employment on 1986—12—31 is continued in employment as such thereafter in 1987.

PART B

Where a chauffeur in employment on 1986—12—31 is continued in employment as such thereafter or a new chauffeur is employed in 1987 or in any subsequent year, with effect from 1987—01—01 and every year thereafter, the chauffeur shall receive the allowance mentioned in the appropriate entry in the second column of Part A and in addition shall be granted —

- (i) such percentage of increase or increases on his basic salary as may be awarded to the Public Service or as allowance for the chauffeur; and
- (ii) such sum, being an increase, on his basic salary as may be awarded by the Minister responsible for finance in the last quarter of that year based on the actual appraisal for the year of the work of the chauffeur.

Note: In this Table basic salary means—

- (i) where the allowance payable on 1987—12—31 is \$968.64 \$ 680.64
- (ii) where the allowance payable on 1987—12—31 is \$1,002.25 \$ 714.25
- (iii) where the allowance payable on 1987—12—31 is \$1,037.19 \$ 749.19
- (iv) where the allowance payable on 1987—12—31 is \$1,089.61 \$ 801.61."
