### THE TRADE ACT

(Cap. 91:;01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Imports not entitled to Community Rate) Order 1988.

Specified goods.
Schedulo
Schedulo, not being goods which are entitled to be accorded a Community rate of duty or an Association rate of duty within the meaning of section 15 of the Customs Act, is hereby prohibited.

Competent Authority.

3. It shall be lawful for the Competent Authority or any premises for the purpose of securing compliance with this Order.

Production of books Competent Authority.

4. For the purpose of security compliance with this Order any person carrying on or employed in connection with any trade or business shall produce to the Competent Authority or any person authorised in writing in that behalf by the Competent Authority such books, accounts or other documents relating to his trade or business as the Competent Authority may require, and shall furnish to the Competent Authority such documents or information as the Competent Authority may, from time to time, require.

Trade (Control of Imports) Order and the Trade (Control of Imports not entitled to Community Rate) Order are hereby revoked.


