THE LABOUR ACT
(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) Order* may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Watchmen) (Amendment) Order 1987, and shall come into operation on 1st July, 1987. Citation and commencement.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following manner — Amendment of the Principal Order.

(a) by the substitution in clause 3(1) thereof, for the words "69.52" of the words "130.68";

(b) by the substitution in clause 3(2) thereof, for the words "1.58" and "12.71" of the words "2.97" and "23.75" respectively.

3. Where immediately before the commencement of this Order a watchman was in receipt of a wage at a rate higher than that prescribed by clause 2 of this Order, the employer shall nevertheless continue to pay to the watchman wages at the higher rate. Higher rates when payable.
