THE GUYANA GOLD BOARD ACT 1981

(Act No. 12 of 1981)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 20A OF THE GUYANA GOLD BOARD ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER.

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Gold Board <sup>Citation.</sup> (Amnesty) Order 1987.

2. Any person who sells during the period commencing <sup>Amnesty</sup> on 14th September, 1987 and ending on 31st December, 1987 <sup>period.</sup> all gold in his possession to the Board shall not be prosecuted under the Act for conveying, purchasing or otherwise acquiring or possessing such gold in contravention of the provisions of the Act, or in the case of the licensee referred to in section 9 for not maintaining the book required to be kept by him by that section in respect of such gold.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order grants, during the prescribed period, amnesty from prosecution to any person, who sells all gold in his possession to the Board, for offences relating to such gold. Such offences are conveying, purchasing or otherwise acquiring or possessing such gold in contravention of the provisions of the Act, or in the case of a person who barter goods for gold, for not maintaining proper account books in respect of such gold.
