THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDERS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Black Bush Polder Small Farm Development Project) Order 1986.
2. The buildings and erections on the land described in the Schedule hereunder are hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Commissioner of Lands and Surveys, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part thereof for the public work aforesaid.
4. The aforesaid land is shown on a plan recorded in the Lands Department as plan No. 19483 and contains an area of 10.007 acres.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land called Area "a" and being parts of Area 'A' and the Western One Third of the Western half of Plantation Tarlogie or Lot No. 34 situate on the Corentyne Coast in the County of Berbice and bounded as follows:—

- On the North:** By the common boundary of Areas "a" and "b";
- On the South:** By the drainage trench on the northern side of the Corentyne Highway;
- On the East:** By the common boundary of the western one third and the eastern two thirds of the western half of Plantation Tarlogie or Lot No. 34; and
- On the West:** By the old Public Road between Wellington Park or Lot No. 33 and Plantation Tarlogie or Lot No. 34.
