THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. (1) This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1986. Citation and commencement.

(2) Clause 2 of this order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1985.

(3) Clause 3 of this order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st June, 1986. Amendment of Clause 6 of the Principal Order.

2. Clause 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended as follows —

- (a) in paragraph (1) (a), by the deletion of the word "and" at the end thereof;
- (b) in paragraph (1) (b), by the substitution for the words "a Service Commission" of the words "the Judicial Service Commission" and for the comma at the end thereof of a semicolon;
- (c) after paragraph (1) (b), by the insertion of the following paragraphs as paragraphs (c) and (d) —

“(c) to the Chairman of the Public Service Commission, the Chairman of the Teaching Service Commission and the Chairman of the Police Service Commission a travelling allowance of \$625.00 per month; and

(d) to every member of the Public Service Commission, the Police Service Commission and the Teaching Service Commission, other than the chairmen thereof, a travelling allowance at the Scale C rate subject to a mileage limit of one hundred miles.”;

(d) by the substitution for paragraph (2) of the following paragraph —

“(2) There shall be paid to the Chairman and every other member of the Elections Commission, not being the owner of a motor car, the actual travelling expenses incurred by them for travel by road for the purpose of performing their official duties.”;

(e) in paragraph 4, by the insertion after the words “Service Commission” of the words “or of the Teaching Service Commission”; and

(f) by the substitution for paragraph (5) of the following paragraph —

“(5) Where any appointed member of the Public Service Commission, the Police Service Commission or the Teaching Service Commission does not own a motor car, there shall be paid to him the actual travelling expenses incurred by him for travel by road for the purpose of performing his official duties.”.

Amendment

3. Clause 9 of the Principal Order is hereby amended as follows —

(a) in paragraph (2), by the substitution for the words “a Service Commission” of the words “the Judicial Service Commission”;

(b) after paragraph 2, by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph 3 —

“(3) Every member of the Public Service Commission, the Police Service Commission and the Teaching Service Commission shall be paid a telephone allowance of fifty dollars per month.”.
