IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 8(1) OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ELECTIONS)
ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Authorities (Elections) ^{Citation}

2. The electoral registrar of every local authority area described ^{Preparation}

FIRST SCHEDULE

(1) THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN

Being all that area comprising the City of Georgetown as provided for by section 7 of the Municipal and District Councils Act (Cap. 28:01).

(2) THE TOWN OF NEW AMSTERDAM

Being all that area comprising the Town of New Amsterdam as provided for by section 28 of the Municipal and District Councils Act (Cap. 28:01).

(3) THE TOWN OF LINDEN

Being all that area comprising the Town of Linden as provided for by clause 2 of the Linden Town (Constitution) Order (0.29/1970).

(4) THE TOWN OF ROSE HALL

Being all that area comprising the Town of Rose Hall as provided for by clause 2 of the Rose Hall Town (Constitution) Order (0.61/1970, as subsequently amended).

(5) THE TOWN OF CORRIVERTON

Being all that area comprising the Town of Corriverton as provided for by clause 2 of the Corriverton (Constitution) Order (0.60/70).

SECOND SCHEDULE

(1) The day not later than which the electoral registrar shall publish the preliminary list under section 12.	Monday 27th October, 1986.
(2) The days to be specified in the notice published under section 12 on which applications may be made for registration as voters.	Monday 27th October, 1986 to Monday 3rd November, 1986, (both days inclusive).

Matters	Days
(3) The days on which objections may be lodged against the inclusion on names in the preliminary list and on which applications may be made by persons whose names appear in the preliminary list for correction of their particulars as shown in the list.	Monday 27th October, 1986 to Monday 3rd November, 1986. (both days inclusive).
(4) The day not later than which the supplementary lists and all forms of objections and applications for correction of particulars shall be sent by the assistant electoral registrar to the electoral registrar under section 19.	Thursday 6th November, 1986.
(5) The day not later than which the electoral registrar shall hear and determine objections and applications for correction of particulars under section 20.	Friday 7th November, 1986.
(6) The day not later than which the electoral registrar shall correct the preliminary and supplementary lists under section 22.	Monday 10th November, 1986.
