## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 185).

UNDER SECTION 16 (2) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. The rates of postage to be paid by members of Her Majesty's Forces in respect of letters and postal packets specified in the first column of the schedule hereto when addressed to places in the United Kingdom or Europe shall be those set out in the second column of the said schedule.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1954.

## SCHEDULE

Nature of Postal Matter	Destination	
	United Kingdom and Europe	
Surface Letters	5 cents up to 1 oz.	2 cents for each additional oz. or part thereof.
Small Packets	2 cents for each 2 ozs. with a minimum charge of 10 cents up to 10 ozs. (2 lb. maximum).	
Air Letters	5 cents up to 1 oz.	5 cents for each additional oz. or part thereof. Maximum 4 lb.
