

## ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940,  
(No. 22 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 46 (1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (James Street) Order, 1953.
2. The following is hereby classified as a major road—  
James Street—at its juncture with Hunter Street.
3. A vehicle proceeding north or south in Hunter Street shall, before entering or crossing James Street, stop at the approach thereto.
