

## ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940,  
(No. 22 of 1940).

UNDER SECTION 46 (1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, 1940, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (New Amsterdam No. 1) Order, 1953.
2. A vehicle shall not proceed west in or along Church Street from its junction with Main Street to its junction with the Strand.
3. The Road Traffic (New Amsterdam) Order, 1952\* is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "Church Street" from the Schedule thereto.
4. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of March, 1953.
