

ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1933,
{(No. 11 of 1933).

UNDER PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 7 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1933, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Variation of boundaries of District No. 1 Essequibo Coast) Order, 1953.

2. The boundaries of District No. 1 Essequibo Coast set out in the First Schedule to the Sea Defence Ordinance, 1933, as varied by the Order in Council made on the 4th day of April, 1935 (published as Notice No. 503 in the *Gazette* of the 6th April, 1935), are hereby further varied by the substitution for the northern and western boundaries of the aforesaid district of the boundaries set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

“**On the North** by the north-western boundary of Plantation Somerset.

On the West by a line commencing at the south-western corner of Plantation Somerset and extending thence about S. 4° E to the Hampton Court Fresh Water Canal, by a line about S. 15° E to the north-western corner of Plantation Belfield.”
