

## ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939,

(No. 31 of 1939).

UNDER SECTION 9A OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939, AS ENACTED BY SECTION 8 OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1947, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Japan) Order, 1953.
2. In this Order "Japan" means all territory which was under Japanese Sovereignty on the 28th day of September, 1944.
3. Japan shall for all purposes of the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance, 1939, and for the purposes of any Order made or in force thereunder cease to be treated as if it were enemy territory.
