

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 185).

UNDER SECTION 16(2) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1945 (No. 7 of 1945), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Air Mail (Rates of Postage) (Parcels) Order, 1953.

2. The rates of postage to be charged and paid in respect of parcels addressed for transmission by Air Mail to places specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, shall be those set out in the second and third columns of the said Schedule.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 2nd day of March, 1953.

4. The Air Mail (Rates of Postage) (Parcels) Order, 1952*, is hereby revoked.
