

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE, 1951,  
(No. 22 of 1951).

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE, 1951, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Amerindian Districts Order, 1953.
2. The Districts set forth in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be Amerindian Districts.

## SCHEDULE.

## 1. NORTH WEST AMERINDIAN DISTRICT.

A tract of Crown Land situate on the right bank Waini River, commencing at the mouth of the Assakata River, left bank Baiara River, left bank Baramanni River, right bank Waini River, and its boundaries extend thence upwards along the right bank Assakata River to its source, thence in a south-easterly direction along the watershed between the Waini and Baiara Rivers to the source of the Kaiarau Creek, right bank Waini River, thence downwards along the left bank Kaiarau Creek to the right bank Waini River, thence upwards along the right bank Waini River to the mouth of Mariwaru River, thence upwards along the right bank Mariwaru River to its source, thence in an easterly direction along the watershed between the Akawini and Wakapau Rivers, left bank Pomeroun River, to a point about (four) 4 miles south-east of a point on the right bank Wakapau River opposite the mouth of Hana-basaigia River, left bank Wakapau River, thence N. 315° (tr.) 4 (four) miles to a point on the right bank Wakapau River opposite the mouth of Hana-basaigia River, thence across the Wakapau River to the mouth of Hana-basaigia River, thence upwards along the right bank Hana-basaigia River to its source, thence, by a straight line running in a north-westerly direction to the mouth of the Manawarin River, right bank Moruca River, thence across the Moruca River to a point on its left bank, thence by a line running in a north-westerly direction through the sources of all the tributary streams on the left bank Moruca River above the aforesaid point, to the source of the Moruca River, thence by a straight line running in a southerly direction to the source of an unnamed creek on the right bank Baiara River about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile below the mouth of Assakata River, thence downwards along the left bank of the said unnamed creek to the right bank Baiara River, thence upwards along the right bank Baiara River to a point opposite the mouth of Assakata River, thence across the Baiara River to the point of commencement at the mouth of Assakata River. Area 705 square miles (approx.).

## 2. UPPER MAZARUNI AMERINDIAN DISTRICT.

A tract of Crown Land being that portion of the drainage basin of the Mazaruni River and its tributaries above the foot of the Serikoeng Falls bounded on the west by the international boundary, on the south by the international boundary and the Ayanganna Mountain, on the east by the Merume escarpment and the Marabaikru cliffs and on the north by the watershed between the Mazaruni and Cuyuni rivers. Area 4,500 square miles (approx.).

## 3. POMEROON — ITURIBISI.

A tract of Crown Land commencing at the mouth of the Aripiako River, right bank Pomeroun River, and its boundaries extend thence upwards along the left bank Aripiako River to a point opposite the mouth of Tapakuma River, thence

across the Aripiaiko River to a point on the left bank Tapakuna River at its mouth, thence in a south-easterly direction along the watershed between the Aripiaiko and Tapakuna Rivers to the watershed between the Tapakuna and Ituribisi Rivers, thence in an easterly direction along the watershed between the Tapakuna and Ituribisi Rivers to the source of the Towanama Creek, thence downwards along the right bank Towanama Creek to its mouth, thence along the northern, western and southern banks of the Ikuraka Lake, thence downwards along the right bank Ikuraka Creek to its mouth, thence by a line due south-west to the watershed between the Ituribisi and Supenaam Rivers, thence in a westerly direction along the watershed between the Ituribisi and Supenaam Rivers to the source of Truli River, right bank Aripiaiko River, right bank Pomeroun River, thence downwards along the right bank Truli River to the right bank Aripiaiko River, thence N.  $314^{\circ} 45'$  (tr.) 29,200 feet, to a point on the left bank Koirimap River about 5,000 feet above the mouth of Markasana Creek, thence N.  $264^{\circ} 30'$  (tr.) 5,280 feet, thence along a line parallel to and one mile from the Koirimap River to a point on the right bank Pomeroun River about 7,000 feet above the mouth of Koirimap River, thence across the Pomeroun River to a point on its left bank, thence N.  $354^{\circ}$  (tr.) 12,000 feet, thence N.  $95^{\circ}$  (tr.) 14,000 feet, thence N.  $127^{\circ}$  (tr.) 16,000 feet to a point on the left bank Pomeroun River opposite the mouth of the Aripiaiko River, thence across the Pomeroun River to the point of commencement. Area 155 square miles (approx.).

#### 4. SANTA.

A tract of Crown land situate on the right bank Kamuni River, left bank Demerara River, commencing at the Mouth of Hurawia Creek and its boundaries extend thence upwards along the right bank Kamuni River to the mouth of the Pokerero River, thence up the right bank Pokerero River to the mouth of Makko or Savan creek, thence upwards along the right bank of the said Makko or Savan creek for 5,500 feet to the mouth of an unnamed creek thence upwards along the right bank of the said unnamed creek to its source thence N.  $122^{\circ} 30'$  (approx.) (true) 7,474 feet to a point on the left bank Hurawia creek about 3,600 feet above a point opposite the mouth of Bimiti creek, thence downwards along the left bank Hurawia creek to the point of commencement. Area 5 square miles (approx.).

#### 5. WIKKI

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Wikki River, right bank Berbice River, commencing at the mouth of the Parakwa creek, left bank Wikki River, and extending thence downwards along the Wikki River to its mouth, thence upwards along the right bank Berbice River to the western extremity of the lower boundary of Klien Poelgeest, thence along the said boundary and its extension to the watershed between the Wikki and Berbice Rivers and thence along the said watershed to the source of the Parakwa creek, thence downwards along the left bank Parakwa creek to the point of commencement. Area 95 square miles (approx.).

#### 6. OREALLA

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Courantyne River commencing at the mouth of Mapenna creek, and its boundaries extend thence N.  $257^{\circ} 45'$  (approx. true)  $9\frac{3}{4}$  miles thence N.  $165^{\circ}$  (approx. true)  $5\frac{3}{4}$  miles thence N.  $77^{\circ} 45'$  (approx. true) 10 miles to a point on the left bank Courantyne River about 3,700 feet below the mouth of Tarakuli creek, thence downwards along the left bank Courantyne River to the point of commencement. Area 54 square miles (approx.).

#### 7. EPIRA.

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Courantyne River commencing at a point about 2,700 feet below the mouth of Epira creek and its boundaries extend thence N.  $304^{\circ} 45'$  (approx. true)  $10\frac{1}{3}$  miles thence N.  $181^{\circ}$  (approx. tr.) 6 miles, thence N.  $124^{\circ} 45'$  (approx. tr.) 10 miles to the mouth of Potoko Creek thence downwards along the left bank Courantyne River to the point of commencement. Area 52 square miles (approx.).

### 8. KARASABAI

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Ireng or Mahu River commencing at the western extremity of the northern boundary of a tract of 50 square miles known as GOOD HOPE held under Cattle Grazing lease No. A.4697 about four miles above a point opposite the mouth of Wansamaru River and its boundaries extend thence eastwards along the said northern boundary of Cattle Grazing Lease A. 4697 to its eastern extremity thence along the brow of Pakaraima Range to Mora River thence up Mora River to its source thence along a straight line to the source of Yurora River, thence due West (true)  $14\frac{1}{4}$  miles to a point on the left bank Ireng or Mahu River about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles below the mouth of Karabarikuru Creek, thence downwards along the left bank of the said Ireng or Mahu River to the point of commencement. Area 208 square miles, approximately.

### 9. KANUKU.

A tract of Crown land situate on the left bank Rupununi River, left bank Essequibo River commencing at the eastern extremity of the southern boundary of a tract of 50 square miles known as Mountain View Ranch held under Grazing Permission No. 174 and its boundaries extend thence upwards along the left bank Rupununi River to the foot of Kanuku Mountains thence westwards along the foot of Kanuku Mountains to the south-eastern corner of the tract of 42.2 square miles held under Permission 13723, thence northwards along the eastern boundaries of the tracts held under Grazing Permissions Nos 13723, 189 and 41 to the north-eastern corner of the tract of 50 square miles held under Grazing Permission No. 41, thence due East along the southern boundary of the tract held under Grazing Permission No. 85 to the right bank Nappi River, thence up the right bank Nappi River to the western extremity of the southern boundary of the tract held under Grazing Permission No. 174, thence due East along the said southern boundary of Grazing Permission 174 to the starting point. Area 220 square miles approximately.

### 10. SAND CREEK.

A tract of Crown land situate on the right bank Rupununi River, commencing at an Iron Paal "D.L.M." at the confluence of the Katiwau or Sand River with the Rupununi River and extending thence upwards along the right bank of the Katiwau or Sand River to a paal branded "E.A.H." 120 feet below the mouth of the Saboruwa Creek a tributary on the right bank of the Katiwau or Sand River, thence N.  $4^{\circ} 20' E.$  (true) 230 feet to a paal branded "E.A.H.", thence N.  $87^{\circ} 20' E.$  (true) 3908 feet, thence N.  $89^{\circ} 20' E.$  (true) 6105 feet, thence N.  $77^{\circ} 50' E.$  (true) 2470 feet, thence N.  $63^{\circ} 20' E.$  (true) 4485 feet, thence N.  $58^{\circ} 50' E.$  (true) 5143 feet, thence N.  $45^{\circ} E.$  (true) 13,700 feet, thence N  $23^{\circ} 30' E.$  (true) 5220 feet, thence N.  $3^{\circ} 30' E.$  (true) 2850 feet, thence down the left bank of the Turukwa Creek to a paal branded "E.A.H." 30 feet from its mouth, thence up the right bank of the Rupununi River to the point of commencement, the whole containing an area of 28 square miles as delineated on a plan by E. A. Haynes, Acting Government Surveyor, dated the 24th September, 1931, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as No. 3665. Area 28 square miles approximately.
