

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER  
THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936.  
(No. 29 of 1936).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1936,  
AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES  
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1953, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY  
THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 4) Order, 1953.

2. In this Order —

“feed” means feed of any kind brought with any poultry;

“litter” means straw, hay or other substance used as bedding for any poultry, and includes excreta of such poultry.

3. On and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, poultry or the carcasses of any poultry, or any portion thereof, or any eggs, feed or litter thereof shall not be brought from Grenada, British West Indies, into the Colony.
